Arts Education Projects funds individual artists, artist collectives and organizations to create and deliver arts education projects in school or community settings. These projects can include any discipline for any age of learner. Examples: performances or arts presentations for young audiences; workshops; arts education conferences or forums; new work aimed at young people; mentorship to develop your teaching skills as an artist. Use your imagination!

Northern Arts Projects funds individual artists, artist collectives and organizations based in Northern Ontario to create, deliver, and disseminate arts projects. Examples: new works; publications, performances, festivals, and exhibition; professional development

Franco-Ontario Arts Programs funds projects designed to assist the creation, production, promotion and presentation of art created in French.

***Arts professionals** are artists, arts administrators, community animators, curators, programmers, technicians and arts educators who are engaged in creating, producing, promoting, performing, presenting, distributing and/or programming artistic work.
